



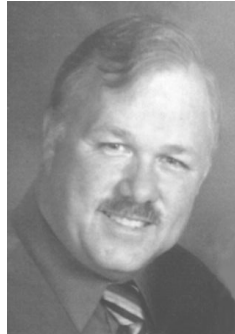

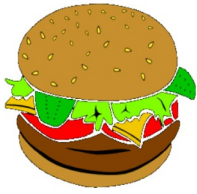
a
